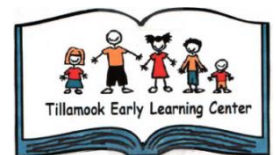
To let us know that you are interested in having your child attend one of the partnership programs, please complete this intake form. The form will provide us with necessary pieces of information so that we may make good recommendations for your young student for an appropriately matched Preschool Promise partner program.

This intake form is not a guarantee of entrance into a specific program. For families that qualify, preschool may be free. For families that do not qualify, we will still make a recommendation to one of our programs. In this case, tuition charges will apply. Staff can suggest tuition assistance options if needed.

In order to be considered for the first round of recommendations, please turn in your completed form by June 3, 2016

Preschool Promise team members will meet and make recommendations. Program recommendations will take into account parent wishes and child needs. All recommendations will be final. Award letters will be sent to families by the end of June. Award letters will include enrollment directions from the enrolling program. Programs will begin providing high quality preschool education programs in September 2016.
